WHAT'S HAPPENING ?

In 2014, Yale First Nation completed a Comprehensive Community Plan (CCP). The Plan set a high-level vision, goals and an action plan which guided the community. Over the last 3 years, we have met many of these goals, and outgrown our Plan.

It is time to make a new CCP! Over the next 4 months, we will be working together with community members to look at where we are now, where we want to be, and how we can get there. The updated Yale First Nation CCP will take us through the next 5- 10 years, towards being healthier, stronger, and more prosperous.



WHO CAN I ASK ABOUT YALE'S CCP UPDATE?

Yale has hired a community planner, Janet Kivett Knight, to manage the project. She is a community planner who has worked with several First Nations on community plans.

WHAT IS A CCP?

Comprehensive Community Planning (CCP) is planning done for Yale, by Yale. CCP is a community-driven planning process that looks at all areas of the community and lays out goals for what we want in the future, and what we can do to get us there.

Each community's CCP will look a little different, but can include a range of topics.

The CCP process is designed to include the values, ideas and experiences of all community members. The completed CCP will:

- describe our values and the future we are working towards
- set goals for different parts of our community
- lay out actions that we should take to meet these goals
- identify who will be responsible, and how we will know we're on track



HOW CAN I BE INVOLVED?

As a Yale member, this is your plan! There will be many different ways for community members to give their input. Starting the week of November 15th we will be holding events on- and off- reserve, and asking you to give feedback through surveys, phone conversations and online.
