The campground is located approximately 15 minutes north of Hope, BC. Duties and responsibilities will include the following:

- Learn and perform safe use of landscaping tools and equipment
- Campsite cleanup and preparation
- Provide a welcoming environment for tourists (conversation, information)
- Campground registration and collection of collection of camping fees
- Sales and Delivery of firewood
- Reporting a variety of information to supervisor on regular basis
- Accurate recording of park visitation numbers
