Yale First Nation (YFN) is seeking a compassionate and dedicated Homecare Worker to provide essential support to Elders and community members who require assistance with daily living. This role is an opportunity to make a meaningful difference in the lives of our members while upholding our traditional values of care, respect, and holistic wellness.

The Homecare Worker will report to the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) and work collaboratively as part of the health team to ensure services are provided effectively and meet the needs of clients. This role requires strong teamwork, communication, and adaptability to support community members holistically.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Personal Care & Assistance: Support clients with daily living activities such as bathing, dressing, grooming, and mobility, if client requires.
- Medical Travel Support: Accompany clients to medical appointments when needed (YFN will provide travel support).
- Nutrition & Meal Preparation: Plan and prepare healthy meals using fresh produce from YFN's gardens and greenhouse while following Food Safe standards.
- Home Management & Safety: Perform light housekeeping duties and monitor home safety.
- Community-Based Travel: Travel between YFN communities along Highway 1 and Highway 7 (approximately 20 minutes apart).
- Team Collaboration: Work closely with the LPN and other healthcare staff to ensure seamless service delivery and holistic care for clients.
- Additional Responsibilities as Needed: Support other duties that contribute to the wellbeing of community members.





QUALIFICATIONS & REQUIREMENTS

- First Aid & CPR Certification (or willingness to obtain)
- Food Safe Level 1 (or willingness to obtain)
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License & Reliable Transportation (YFN will provide travel support)
- Experience in homecare, personal support work, or a related field is an asset
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills, with a compassionate and patient-centered approach
- Ability to work independently while collaborating with the LPN and the health team
- Understanding and respect for Indigenous culture, traditions, and community values
